Each reference only needs to be a paragraph (150-word minimum). Those providing references should send them directly to your Guidance Department.

Part VII: High School Transcript



The application deadline is **April 11th** (to your Guidance Department), and the student awarded the grant will be notified at the Nanuet HS Senior Awards assembly at the end of May. Payment of the grant award will be made directly to the student’s college/trade school for the benefit of their account before the fall semester. Please note, the grant is non-renewable.

After completing your sections of this application and attaching the appropriate documentation, please submit all paperwork to your Guidance Counselor for certification and delivery to the Nanuet Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Selection Committee.
